ACTIVITY PLAN - INTRO 2

Intro

Theme Warm up activity **Title** How is cricket scored?

Curriculum area Numerac

Learning objectives

To use simple addition and subtraction to work out a cricket target score.

Room layout and preparation

Class in normal class situation in small groups.

Starter activity

Display a team cricket score with the **Scoring in cricket** presentation and ask the group to add up the runs to get a total.

Main activity

Use the **Scoring in cricket** presentation to look at how cricket matches are scored.

Go through the different examples of the type of scores that occur in a cricket game and ask the group to calculate what the second team have to achieve in order to win the game.

• Example (not in the presentation)

Team 1 scores - 428
Team 2 scores - 378
Team 1 scores - 252

What does Team 2 need to score to win?

Team 1 total score = 428 + 252 = 680 Team 2 needs to score 680 - 378 = 302 to tie So they need 303 to win

Opportunities for differentiation

For lower year groups smaller numbers could be used e.g.

Team A scores 50 Team B scores 60 Team A scores 40

What does Team B need to score to win?

Where the session is leading...

Knowing the way a cricket game is scored will help to follow other sessions, this will be followed up in session 3 and 5.
