Theme	International Twenty20 activity
Title	Being a cricket expert
Curriculum area	Literacy and research skills, ICT to present if appropriate

Where has this session come from...

The whole project has been about exploring different aspects of cricket and 'The Ashes'. This now gives the pupils a chance to research about an area that interests them.

Learning objectives

To research in some detail about an aspect of The Ashes.
To present your research in an appropriate way.

Room layout and preparation

Initially the pupils will spend time researching by themselves or in small groups.

When they are presenting their ideas, an ideal layout would be a theatre style layout to allow formal presentations of the pupil's research.

It will probably require Whiteboard projection and place to display 'posters'.

Main activity

Carry out a discussion about the many aspects of 'The Ashes' tour and identify possible research projects.

- The current teams.
- Ashes Legends.
- Any players from local county teams.
- Women's cricket.
- How to raise the profile of cricket.
- Using technology in cricket to make umpiring decisions.

Each pupil or group then chooses one project and spends time researching and presenting it.

Then, whoever has produced a research project presents the project either to the class, or as part of a wider

Opportunities for differentiation

Different levels of support for the presentations will be necessary here to allow pupils to achieve.

Assessment opportunities

The assessment opportunities of this depend on the nature of the projects undertaken. They could be writing or speaking and listening assessment focus.
